





can occur separately, but are often found in the same child simultaneously. Spina bifida (pronounced spy-na biffidda) is a congenital malformation caused by failure of the nerves of the spine to sink below the skin during a baby's development in the womb.

One child is born with this defect, somewhere in the U.K., about every three hours. You may not have heard of it before, however, because until recently there were few survivors to be seen. A few years ago, however, medical men achieved important advances which have increased the survival rate from around 20 per cent to over 50 per cent.

Hydrocephalus ("water on the brain") occurs in about threequarters of all SB cases. Fluid collects in the head, causing enlargement of the skull and in severe cases brain damage. This serious complication was the chief cause of death in SB cases, but now it can be controlled by implanting an ingenious valve in the head. This invention, and advances in surgery, have revolutionised the outlook for the affected children.

Today we are witnessing the growth of the "first generation" of successfully treated serious cases of SB and hydrocephalus. For the first time, medical, welfare and educational facilities will have to be provided for large numbers of SB children.

ASBAH needs your help in meeting this challenge. It also needs money for research into the cause and prevention of both these conditions . . . "accidents of nature" which can turn any "happy event" into a time of grief and shock.

The Association

for Spina Bifida & Hydrocephalus Ltd. sprang out of various local associations of parents and was incorporated in 1966. Its constitution allows it to maintain clinics, schools, homes, employment centres; to improve facilities for the treatment and welfare of sufferers; to raise funds for research, equipment or any other means to the end of helping victims. As this leaflet goes to press, detailed research is being carried out to determine future needs and establish priorities.

Most important of all, perhaps, membership of ASBAH provides social contact and comfort for those affected, especially new parents, who often have no idea of what the future holds or how to cope with their new problems. Many local associations also have adult victims among their members.
